He completed M.S. from the University of Kentucky and Ph.D. from the University of California at Davis. After working for two large US companies, he founded an engineering consulting company in California and ran that company as its President for 12 years. Later Dr. Saquib merged his company with Woodard & Curran and is currently serving as a senior partner. In 2018, Dr. Saquib

received the prestigious Hugo Fischer Award from the California Water and Environmental Modeling Forum as recognition for his 25 years of contribution to the field of water resources modeling. He is a leading consultant to the California Department of Water Resources and provides services on strategic planning, water management, water resources modeling, and information management. His interest lies in project management, leadership, philosophy, literature, religion, chess, and music.
